WE RESPOND IN CONFESSION

In Response To: 1 Corinthians 11:27–29; Luke 22:19–20; 1 Thessalonians 5:18

Heavenly Father, we confess that we have forgotten what you delivered to us.

We have received your gifts with ingratitude, failing to give thanks as Christ gave thanks.

We have broken fellowship instead of breaking bread together.

We have lived for ourselves rather than remembering his sacrifice.

We have proclaimed our own glory instead of proclaiming the Lord's death.

We have sought new covenants of our own making rather than trusting in the new covenant of his blood.

Transform us by your grace to be a people who remember, who give thanks, and who proclaim Christ's death until he comes.

SCRIPTURE RESPONSES

1 Corinthians 11:27–29 Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty concerning the body and blood of the Lord. Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself.

Luke 22:19–20 And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, “This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.” And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, “This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.”

1 Thessalonians 5:18 Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
